Formula: A mixture of Ammonium Sulfate [$(\text{NH}_4)_2\text{SO}_4$], Diammonium Phosphate [$(\text{NH}_4)_2\text{HPO}_4$], and Muriate of Potash [KCl] packaged in a controlled-release packet.

NOTE: The guaranteed analysis of Nutri-Pak fertilizer is 12% total Nitrogen to 4% available Phosphoric Acid to 12% available Potash (12-4-12). Custom orders for varying ratios can be accommodated.

Product Characteristics: Plant food for Palms: packaged for controlled release over A one to two year period in ½ oz. packet, three to five years in a 2 oz. packet.
